We are also accepting applications from applicants who are able to self-fund their studies. The cost of tuition fees per academic year is €5000 for international/non-EU students and €2500 for EU/UK students.

You should have a background in marine science or biology, fisheries, aquaculture, aquatic science and/or environmental studies, and you must complete in full two application forms – a University of the Highlands and Islands (UHI) and ACES application form.
