ABOUT THE HELLENIC INITIATIVE CANADA SCHOLARSHIP

Canada is a great place to study, offering consistently high-quality education across the country. Canada ranks high in the global ranking of its universities and is among the best countries for international students. The quality of life in Canada is consistently ranked in first place. Canada also has a rich multicultural society and a vibrant Greek diaspora active in offering community programs, events and services.

The Hellenic Initiative Canada Scholarship Program will provide financial support for students to study at the Master's level at any accredited university in Canada. The program will also provide opportunities for students to develop skills, connections and experience that will allow them to lead successful careers and contribute to the future growth and prosperity of Greece.

Scholarships will be awarded to outstanding students who are Greek citizens, residing in Greece at the time of application, with a preference for candidates who intend to return to Greece upon completion of studies. The scholarship program will also prioritize students studying in areas that are in high demand in the Greek workforce, such as studies in leading-edge technologies or specialized fields that respond to gaps in the job market.

Scholarships are valued at \$10,000 CAD and will be awarded to at least two qualifying students to be applied toward tuition and/or living expenses. Applicants must submit an online application and all relevant documentation by March 15, 2024.
